Existing laws – Law No. 62 Penal Code, Law No.22 Military Offences Act, Law No. 81 on the Environment, and Decree-Law No. 262 on Weapons and Ammunition – which include penal sanctions, are considered by Cuba as sufficient to implement the CCM
