Signed: 12 November 2009 Ratified: 14 May 2013 Entered into force: 1 November 2013



# Article 3 - Stockpile destruction and retention

Completed destruction of its cluster munition stockpiles before the Convention entered into force for it

#### Article 4 - Clearance and risk reduction education

Clearance obligation deadline: 1 November 2023

Estimated contaminated area: 195.26 million m<sup>2</sup>

Clearance of 7.17 million m<sup>2</sup> in 2018

Expressed challenges in meeting obligation deadline such as a lack of capacity, discovery of new contaminated land, erosion factors such as rain and floods, and difficulties in locating exact locations of cluster munition strikes

#### Article 5 - Victim assistance

Has cluster munition victims

National focal point designated

National Mine Action Strategy Plan for 2018 - 2021 being implemented

State Party to Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities since 20 March 2013

### Article 6 - International cooperation and assistance

Has requested assistance to fulfil Article 4 and Article 5 obligations

Donors in 2018 included: Australia, Belgium, Canada, Germany, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Sweden, and United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

Initial transparency report submitted in April 2013

Annual reports submitted covering: 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018

### **Article 9 - National implementation measures**

Consultations on national legislation to implement the CCM is taking place
