Provided financial assistance in 2017 for implementation of Articles 3 and 4 through the United Nations Mine Action Service, and Article 5 through the International Committee of the Red Cross

Provided financial assistance in 2017 for implementation of Article 4 or 5 to: Lao People's Democratic Republic, Myanmar, Solomon Islands, Syria, West Bank, and Yemen
