Had requested for assistance to fulfil Article 3 obligations

Received assistance from Norwegian People's Aid and the governments of Germany and Norway to fulfil Article 3 obligations

Article 7 - Transparency measures

Initial transparency report submitted on 9 September 2011

Annual reports submitted covering: 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017

Article 9 - National implementation measures

Stated at the First Meeting of States Parties (1MSP) of the CCM that the CCM became an integral part of its domestic legislation after ratification
