Article 3 - Stockpile destruction and retention

Completed destruction of its cluster munition stockpiles before the Convention entered into force for it

Article 4 - Clearance and risk reduction education

Clearance obligation deadline: 1 November 2023

Estimated contaminated area: 189.60 km²

Cleared 33.62 km², cancelled 12.46 km² and reduced 2.18 km² (total land released: 48.26 km²) in 2022

Submitted request for deadline extension up to 1 November 2028

Article 5 - Victim assistance

Has cluster munition victims

National focal point designated

National Mine Action Strategy Plan for 2022-2028 that includes provisions for victim assistance being implemented

State Party to Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities since 20 March 2013

Article 6 - International cooperation and assistance

Has requested assistance to fulfil Article 4 and Article 5 obligations

Donors in 2022 included: Belgium, Canada, Germany, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, and Sweden

Article 7 - Transparency measures

Initial transparency report submitted in April 2013

Annual reports submitted covering: 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022

Article 9 - National implementation measures

Existing laws – Weapons Law, Iraqi Penal Code, Customs Law, and Anti-Terrorism Law – which include penal sanctions, are considered by Iraq as sufficient to implement the CCM
