Article 9 - National implementation measures

Enacted <u>Law n. 95/2011</u> that authorized Italy's ratification of the Convention and includes penal sanctions as required by the CCM

Drafted <u>Measures for the prevention of financing the manufacturers of anti-personnel mines, cluster munitions and submunitions</u> in 2016 (pending approval) to prohibit all types of financial support to companies that operate in any phase of the production and commercialization of cluster munitions (<u>English translation available</u>)
