Background




Danish MoD decided in late 2011 to speed up the destruction process.



- The destruction process started in mid 2012.



- The company chosen for the destruction is Denex.





Scope



Destruction of:

27.000 ea DM 642 / 155 mm
15.000 ea DM 662 / 155 mm
20 ea Rockeye MK-20 / bombs


A total of 2.440.940 explosive submunitions.

Retention




- Denmark will keep 2700 (1st august 2018) pieces of sub-munitions for training purpose.
- The submunition will be separated from the shell and stored in carbon tubes – and hence not operational anymore.
