# Cluster Munitions planned for DESTRUCTION

## Current status of the destruction process

- All cluster munitions have been separated from operational stockpiles
- Early July 2013: DDPS chooses Nammo Buck GmbH, Germany as principal contractor for the destruction
- Approx. September 2013: Signing of the contract
- Last quarter of 2013: Start of **transport** to destruction sites in Germany (Nammo Buck GmbH) and Norway (Nammo NAD) and start of **destruction process**
