- ✓ ALL STOCKPILED CLUSTER MUNITIONS WERE DESTROYED IN COOPERATION BETWEEN MINISTRY OF DEFENCE B&H AND UNDP
- ✓ EU FUNDED PROCESS - 725.259 €
- ✓ METOD OF DESTRUCTION – DELABORATION AND OPEN DETONATION
- ✓ TOTAL CLUSTER MUNITIONS DESTROYED: 455
- ✓ TOTAL CLUSTER SUBMUNITIONS DESTROYED: 148.059
- RETAINED FOR TRAINING: 30 KB-1 (NPA)
