# Article 3 - Stockpile destruction and retention

Completed destruction of its cluster munition stockpiles before the Convention entered into force for it

# Article 4 - Clearance and risk reduction education

Clearance obligation deadline: 1 March 2022

Estimated contaminated area: 5.8 million m<sup>2</sup>

Clearance of 3.6 million m<sup>2</sup> in 2019

Expected clearance completion at the end of 2021

# Article 5 - Victim assistance

Has cluster munition victims

National focal point designated

Draft National Disability Strategy is being reviewed by UNMAS and a technical committee

State Party to Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities since 18 September 2012

#### Article 6 - International cooperation and assistance

Has requested assistance to fulfil Articles 4 and 5 obligations

Donors in 2019 included: Australia, Canada, Germany, Ireland, Japan, Netherlands, Spain, Sweden, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and United States of America

# **Article 7 - Transparency measures**

Initial transparency report submitted on 30 August 2012

Annual reports submitted covering: 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019

# Article 9 - National implementation measures

Adopted prohibitions on cluster munitions as <u>Annex no. 1 of Law on Firearms, Ammunition and Explosive Materials</u> in 2018 that includes penal sanctions as required by the CCM and also prohibits investment in cluster munitions
