Article 3 - Stockpile destruction and retention

Stockpile destruction deadline: 1 March 2019

Reported to have destroyed 4,430 kg of ammunition and to have a remaining 111,823 kg / 2,755 units of ammunition that are unidentified; requested assistance in identifying cluster munitions for destruction

A late extension request expected to be submitted in the near future

Article 4 - Clearance and risk reduction education

Completed clearance of cluster munition remnants before the Convention entered into force for it

Article 5 - Victim assistance

Reported on UXO victims, unsure if the UXOs were cluster munitions, and requested assistance in identifying the ammunition

National focal point designated

State Party to Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities since 24 September 2014

Article 6 - International cooperation and assistance

Has requested assistance to fulfil Articles 3 and 5 obligations

Article 7 - Transparency measures

Initial transparency report submitted on 20 November 2019

Existing law is considered by Guinea-Bissau as sufficient to implement the CCM
