Article 3 - Stockpile destruction and retention

Does not have cluster munition stockpiles

Article 4 - Clearance and risk reduction education

Does not have any contamination in areas under its jurisdiction or control

Article 5 - Victim assistance

Does not have cluster munition victims

Article 6 - International cooperation and assistance

Provided financial assistance since 2018 for EWIPA campaign against use of explosive weapons in populated areas and victim assistance

Article 7 - Transparency measures

Initial transparency report submitted on 10 August 2011

Annual reports submitted covering: 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020

Article 9 - National implementation measures

Has not enacted specific legislation to implement the CCM
