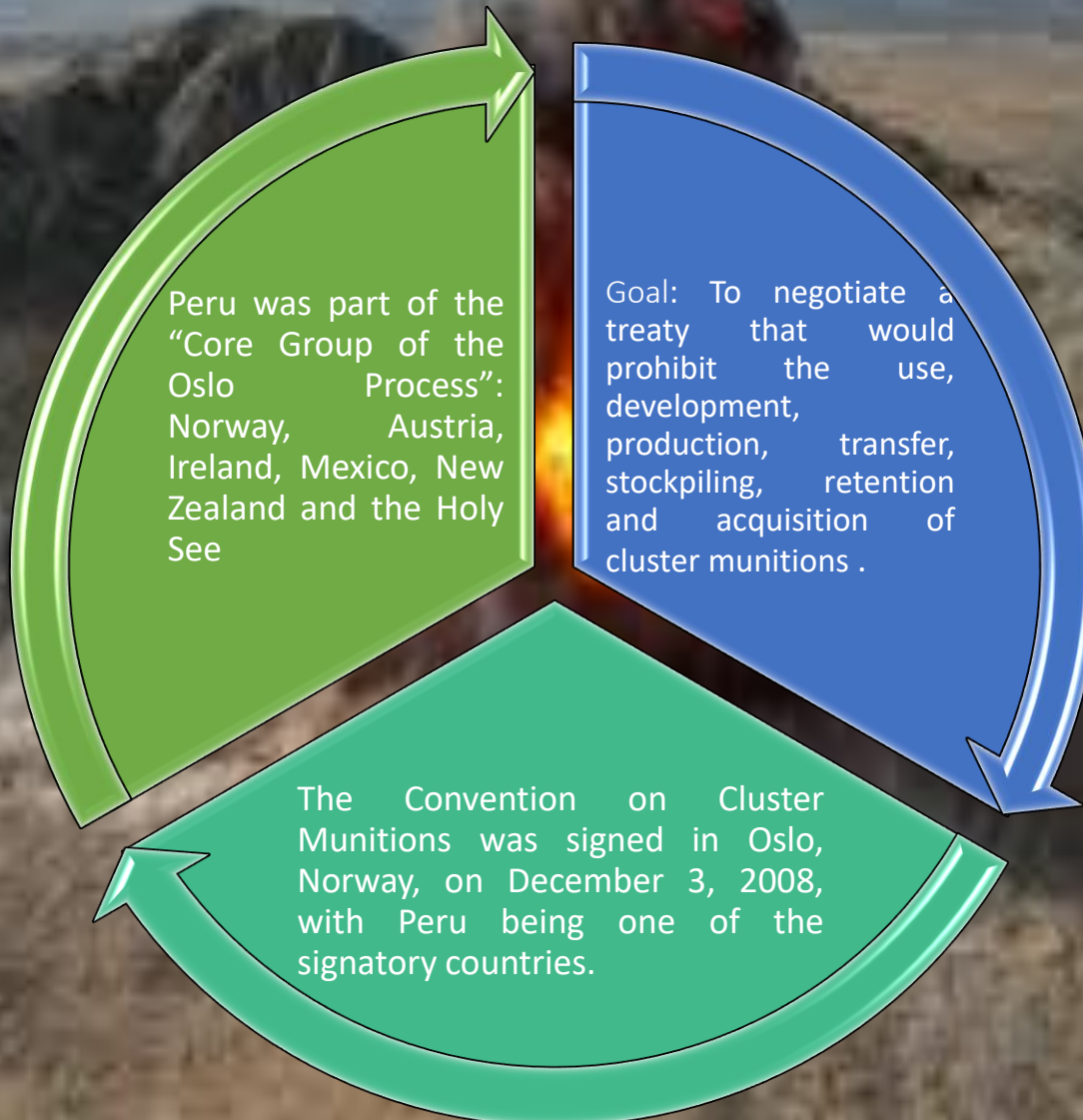

## Convention on Cluster Munitions



- Peru joined the Oslo Convention on September 26, 2012, and it entered into force for our country on March 1, 2013.
- The commitment: Destroy its arsenals of cluster bombs.

## Peru's Challenge and Assistance from the International Community



In compliance with its obligations under Article 3 of the Oslo Convention, the following were destroyed:

- 2,021 Cluster bombs
- 8,445 6 kg bomblets

Peru requested cooperation and assistance from the international community to destroy stockpiles of cluster munitions

In March 2014, the Kingdom of Norway confirmed cooperation for the destruction of cluster munitions in Peru

The support of the Kingdom of Norway was channeled through the NGO "Norwegian People's Aid" (NPA)

## Successful Compliance



On 15 December 2023, the destruction of cluster bombs was completed (4 months before the deadline), thus honouring the obligations under the Oslo Convention (Art. 3, stockpile destruction).
