Request for international support

Geneva, April, 2025

Background

On September 19, 2022, at the 10th Meeting of States Parties to the Convention on Cluster Munitions, Chile's 3rd extension request was approved until June 1, 2026.

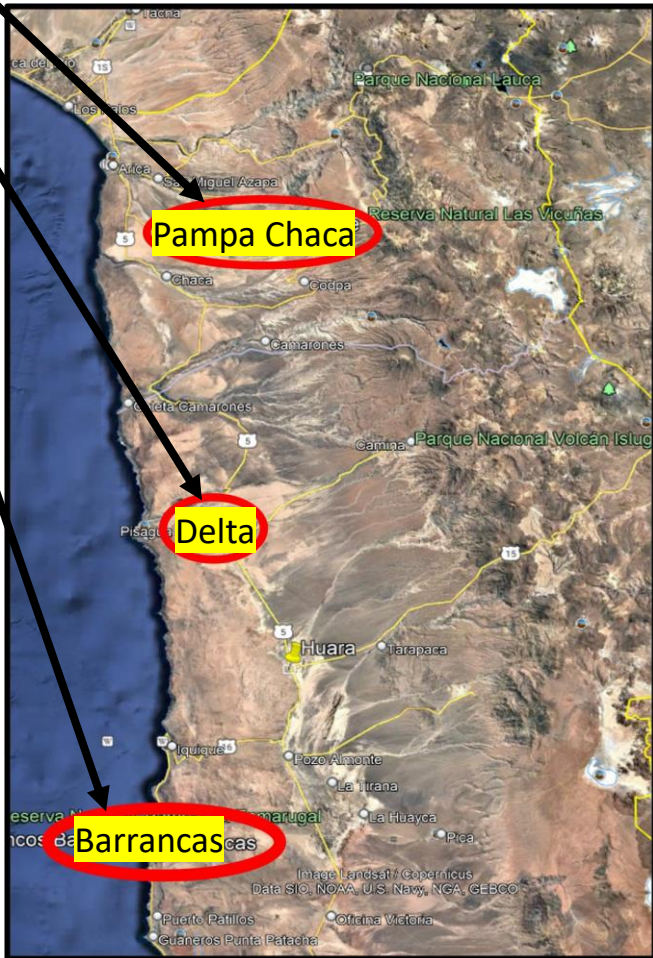
During the 3 year extension period (2023-2026), the following activities were carried out:

- In **2023**, the clearance and destruction of cluster munition remnants on the "Punta Zenteno" Air Force range in the Magallanes Region.
- In **2024**, a new technical survey was conducted on the Delta Air Force range in the Tarapacá Region, and 8,088,374 m² were reduced.

In **2025**, we are seeking resources, requesting international assistance, restructuring our planning and presenting a 4th extension request.

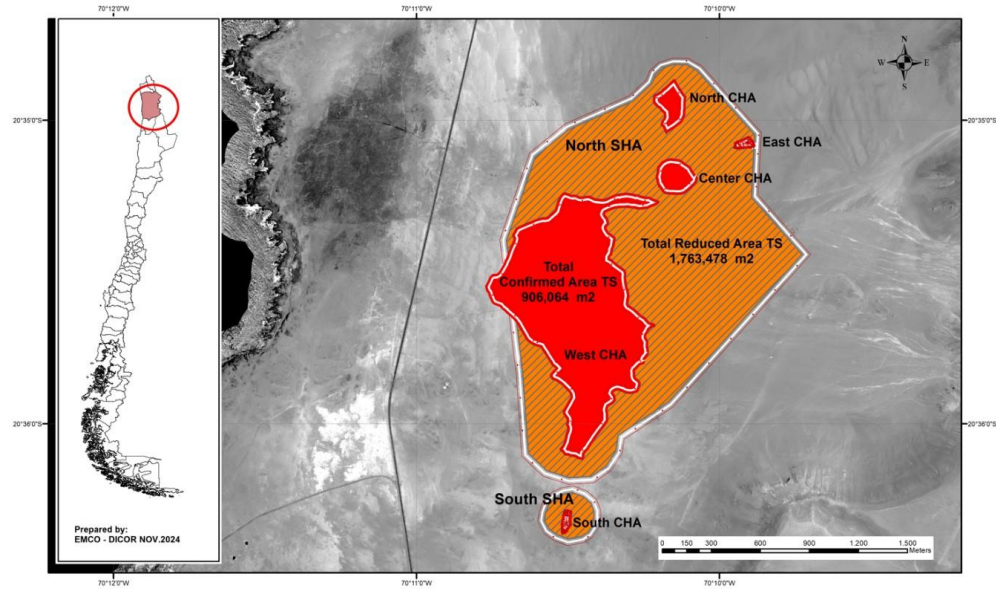

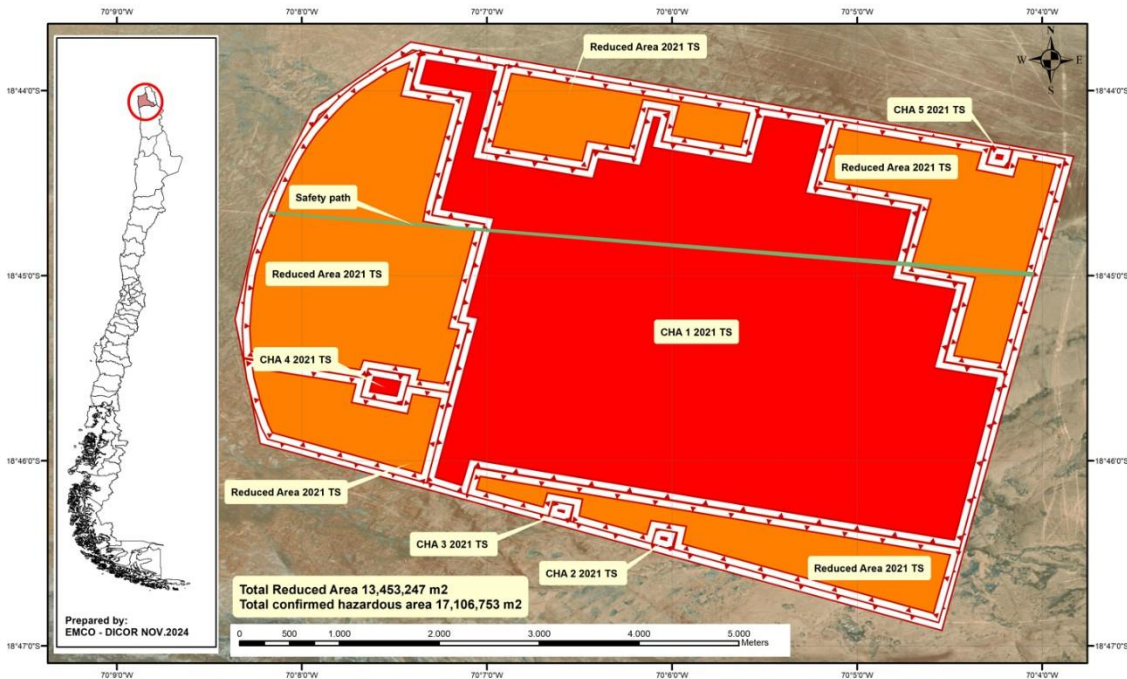

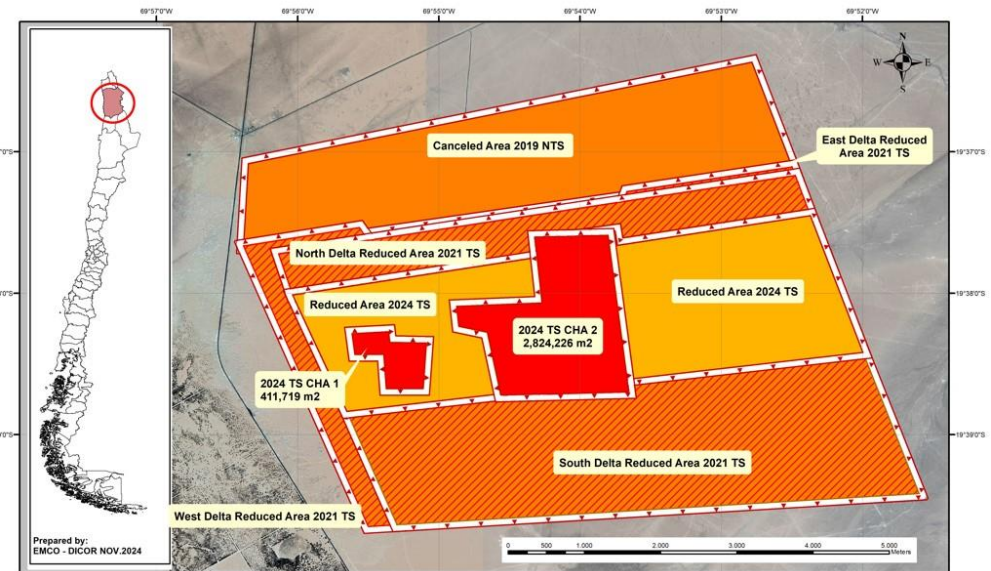
Barrancas Air Force Shooting Range, Tarapacá Region

International assistance requested

- However, regarding the optimal equipment required, as the Analysis Group recommended, a larger number of detectors would be needed to provide 1 for each pair of EOD operators.
- Additionally, due to the war in Europe, the cost of the equipment has increased.
- Chile appreciates the advice of the Analysis Group in this process.



International assistance needed

January 31, 2025, Meeting in Santiago, at the MOFA where representatives from the following countries participated: Germany, Norway, Finland, Italy, Japan, Spain and the EU.
