Obligation and commitments

Article 14, Convention on Cluster Munitions

The costs of the Meetings of States Parties, the Review Conferences and the Amendment Conferences shall be borne by the States Parties and States not party to this Convention participating therein, in accordance with the United Nations scale of assessment adjusted appropriately. 2. The costs incurred by the Secretary-General of the United Nations under Articles 7 and 8 of this Convention shall be borne by the States Parties in accordance with the United Nations scale of assessment adjusted appropriately.

Action 19, Lausanne Action Plan

Pay their assessed contributions in line with Article 14 of the Convention as early as possible after the issuance of invoices and swiftly settle any arrears, as well as provide for the effective resourcing of the Implementation Support Unit (ISU) in accordance with decisions taken regarding its financing, bearing in mind the importance to rely on a financially sound Convention and on an effective machinery.
