

**Japan's intervention (10 (f) International Cooperation and Assistance)**

Thank you, Mr President.

At the outset, Japan commends the efforts of the President, Coordinators, the ISU, and other stakeholders in promoting international support and cooperation.

Japan, as a State Party to the CCM and other relevant conventions, and from the perspective of the Humanitarian, Development, and Peace Nexus, actively cooperates internationally on mine and unexploded ordnance countermeasures. In fiscal year 2024, Japan provided more than 35 million USD in bilateral assistance and cooperation through international organizations in 22 countries and various regions, targeting mine and unexploded ordnance clearance, victim assistance, and risk education, among others.

We will continue to make efforts to provide necessary assistance in this field, through the CCM Meetings of the States Parties, consultations among the Parties, and on-site needs assessments.
