

STATEMENT BY NIGERIA AT THE SECOND PREPARATORY MEETING OF THE
3RD REVIEW CONFERENCE OF THE CCM

1st July. 2026

Thank you, Mr. President.

My delegation wishes to express its sincere appreciation to your Government and People for your leadership and the considerable effort invested in preparing the draft Vientiane Capital Action Plan. We also thank the Coordinators and all those who have contributed to the development of this important document.

At this stage, my capital is still carefully studying the draft text, and we therefore reserve the right to provide more detailed comments at a later stage.

That said, I would like to underline one point of principle. My delegation will not be in a position to support the inclusion of non-consensual language or formulations in the Action Plan. We believe that this document should be based on language that has already been agreed by States Parties and should preserve the consensus-based nature of our work.

In this regard, my delegation aligns itself with the interventions made by other like-minded delegations before us in support of the use of consensual expressions and formulations throughout the draft.

We look forward to engaging constructively in the negotiations with a view to reaching a balanced and broadly supported outcome.
